



# **2016 CRMC Supplementary Regulations Appendix D**

## **CRMC Club Championship Conditions**

### **1. Machine Eligibility:**

Open to machines possessing a CRMC Eligibility Certificate, and be substantially unchanged from the specification declared on the requisite Eligibility Application Form. The interpretation of the eligibility rules is entirely the province of the CRMC eligibility sub committee and / or the CRMC management committee whose decisions will be final and binding.

### **2. Fuel:**

Random fuel tests may be carried out during the season to check the legality of fuel used by competitors. Competitors and / or entrants must ensure that at least 2 litres of fuel remain in the petrol tank of their machine at the end of each race in order that samples may be taken. Failure to have sufficient fuel for testing at the end of the race will result in the same sanctions imposed as for failing the fuel test. The use of E85 Bio fuel is not permitted

### **3. Standard of Preparation:**

In addition to being CRMC eligible competitors and / or entrants are expected to prepare their machines to a high standard in keeping with the Classic period.

### **4. Protests:**

Any protests must be carried out as per instructions in the ACU handbook with the following exception - the organisers reserve the right to order engine measurement of any machine competing in these races without reimbursement of the costs involved.

### **5. Sanctions:**

Any competitor and / or entrant found to be in breach of 2 above will be excluded from the results and lose Championship points or awards for the meeting at which the offence occurred and all previous meetings. Any competitor and / or entrant found to be in breach of 1, 2 & 4 above will be excluded from the results and lose Championship points or awards for the meeting at which the offence occurred. Further sanctions may be applied at the discretion of the organisers.

### **6. Points allocation:**

Points will be awarded from 1<sup>st</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> place on the following scale –

1st	2nd	3rd	4th	5th	6th	7th	8th	9th	10th	11th	12th	13th	14th	15th
25pt	20pt	16pt	13pt	11pt	10pt	9pt	8pt	7pt	6pt	5pt	4pt	3pt	2pt	1pt

In the event of a tie, the greater number of 1st places, 2<sup>nd</sup> places and so on will resolve the tie.

### **7. Rounds:**

Rounds will be held at all CRMC meetings with the best 22 results to count for the championship.



Events 7a & 7b will run in conjunction with Class 7c (1300 UK National Series) and have 18 rounds from which the best 16 results are to count.

It should be noted that races are frequently made up of more than one class and the combination may vary from meeting to meeting in line with varying support levels. It cannot be guaranteed that if you are competing in more than one championship the classes you have entered will always be in separate races.

### **8. Overarching Regulations:**

ACU regulations, standing regulations, supplementary regulations and final instructions all contain regulatory material which may or may not have a bearing on the UK races.

### **9. Overall Interpretation:**

The overall interpretation of the CRMC Club Championship rules 2014 is entirely the province of the CRMC management committee.

### **10. Awards:**

Championship Trophies will be awarded to the winner second & third, and presented in each Championship Class at the CRMC Annual Dinner Dance.
